



Refund Policy

This refund policy has been developed in such a way to both protect the financial interests of Beaumont Curling Club members and to ensure that the club remains sufficiently viable so that curling can be offered for subsequent seasons.

- Full payment of league fees are due on or before October 31st at the absolute latest. Memberships may be revoked by those with outstanding fees after this date.
- **25% of all league fees are non-refundable.** This is to cover fixed costs including ice install and removal, management, and lease payments, among other smaller yet apparent costs.
- In the event that the club is unable to provide league curling due to closure by public health requirements, any catastrophic event like fire, or other reasons such as plant failure, **the remaining 75% of fees will be prorated based on the number of games played.** If three quarters ($\frac{3}{4}$) or more of the season is played, no refund will be offered.
- If the club is able to reopen in the same season, **up to four (4) weeks of games may be rescheduled to alternative weeks** (remaining on the same respective league day).
- If refunds are needed, they will not be processed until the end of the scheduled season.
- No credits or refunds will be offered for rescheduled games, or for games missed by individual players for any reason (including as a result from illness).
- If a player or team chooses to withdraw from a league anytime after the first game of the season has been played, league fees will be non-refundable; (refund approval by the Board).

Special requests will be subject to approval by the Board of Directors and/or the President. The General Manager cannot give approval, but will forward your request to the appropriate person(s).

The Beaumont Curling Club kindly asks all members to consider donating their refund amount.

Beaumont Curling Club Refund Policy - Version 1

Approval Date - September 14, 2021

Effective Date - September 14, 2021 until Version 2

Reviews will be made on an annual basis.

These are some examples of scenarios that we may encounter:

Scenario #1) The season has 20 scheduled games. The club has to close for the remainder of the season. Only 4 games were played.

- League Fees = \$400.00/Season (\$20/Game)
- Non-Refundable Amount = \$100.00 (25% of \$400)
- Potentially Refundable Amount = \$300.00
- Games Played: 4 = \$80 worth of games played (\$20/game x 4 games)
- Refund Calculation: \$300.00 - \$80 = **\$260 refund**

Scenario #2) The season has 20 scheduled games. The club has to close for the remainder of the season. Only 15 games were played.

- **A refund will not be offered as at least three quarters (¾) of the season was played.**

Scenario #3) If the club is open for 4 weeks, then closes for 9, and then reopens, the following can occur:

- If the club can reschedule 4 weeks, a total of 15 games would be played (only 5 games missed) meaning **no refund** because three quarters (¾) of the season was played.
 - 4 games initially + 7 games after reopening + 4 rescheduled games = 15 games played
- If the club cannot reschedule any weeks, a total of 11 games would be played (only 9 games missed) meaning **a refund would be calculated using the method in Scenario #1** because less than three quarters (¾) of the season was played.
 - 4 games initially + 7 games after reopening = 11 games played
